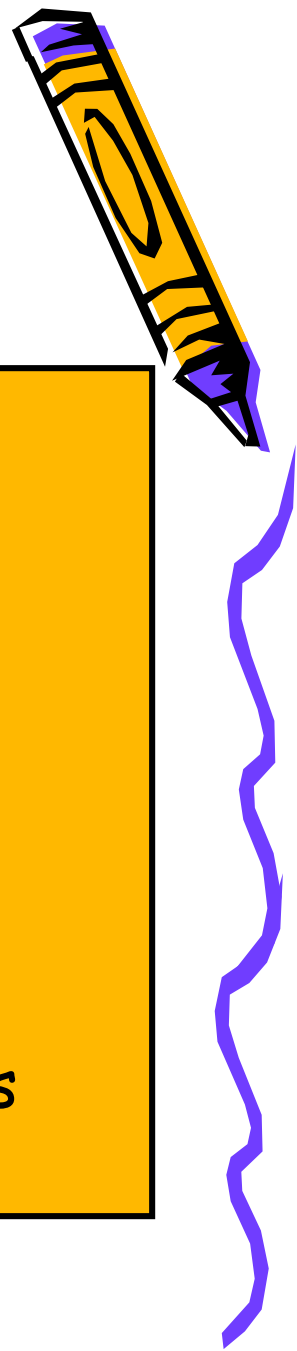


WHAT IS TITLE 1?

- A variety of supplemental teaching methods and materials

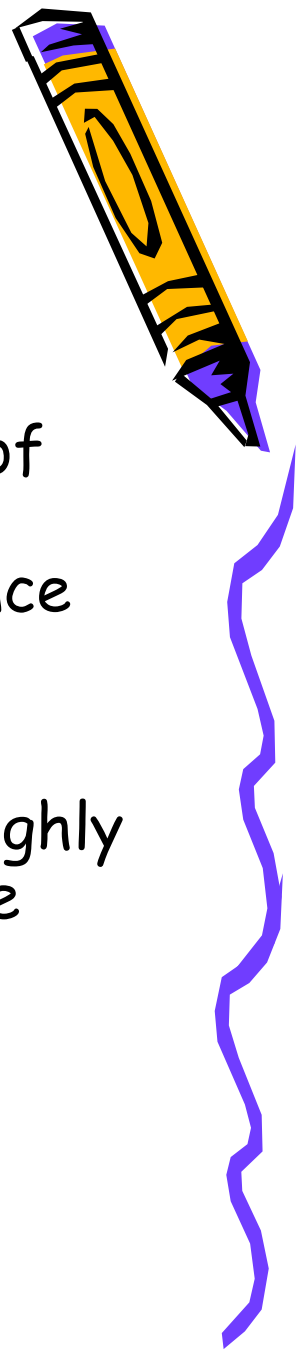


Free Tutoring

- Information will be mailed to parents of eligible students



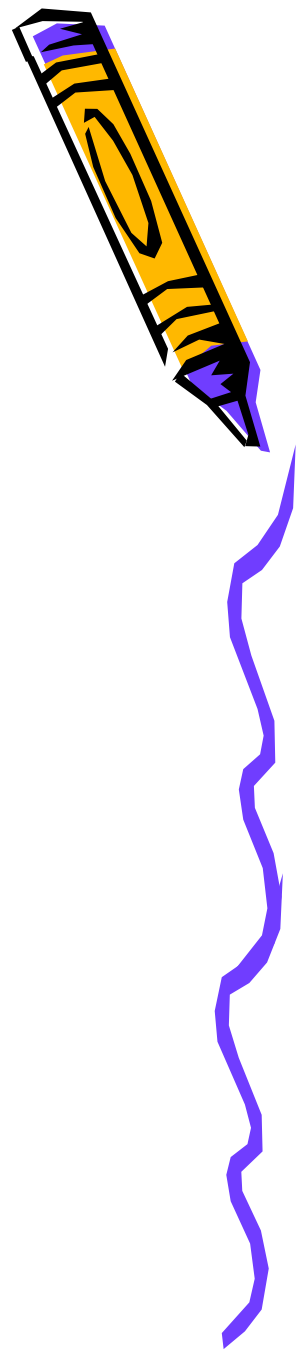
Parent's Rights



- Be involved and request regular meetings to express your opinions and concerns
- Be provided information on your child's level of achievement on assessments like FSA in reading/language arts, mathematics, and science
- Request and receive information on the qualifications of your child's teacher
- Be informed if your child is taught by a non-highly qualified teacher for four or more consecutive weeks



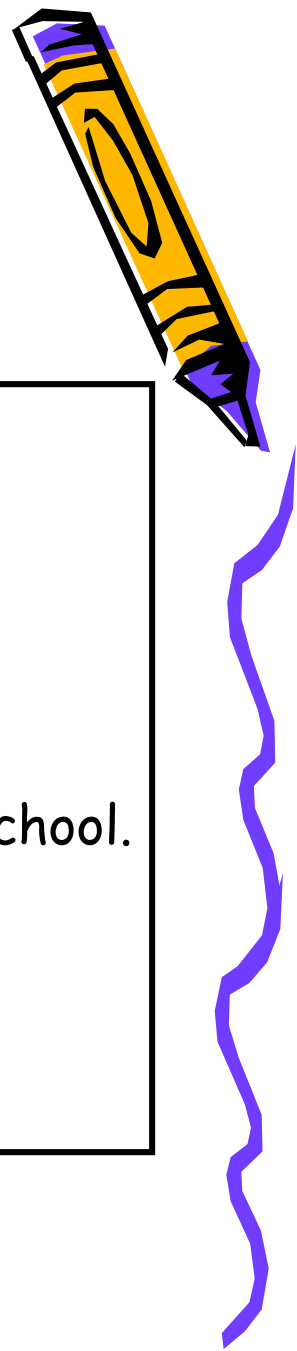
Who decides how funds are used?
