Eligibility requirements for the above offices include:

- Each student may apply for only one position.
- Applicants must have as of beginning of the 2022 - 2023 school year and continue to maintain throughout the 2022 - 2023 school year, an **unweighted** minimum grade point average of 2.5, have no “F”s as final grades in any school year that have not been forgiven by a “C” or better, and no conduct grade below a “C” for the current and previous school years. Failure to maintain academic grades and conduct grades at these levels will result in suspension and possible removal from office.
- Applicants must not have any outdoor suspensions during or since their freshman year of high school. Any officer who receives a referral at any time this school year will be removed from office.
- Applicants who are elected may not hold an officer position in the Robert Morgan as President or Treasurer in any school club or society.
- Those running for office should try to include a leadership period. Those running for the position of President **MUST** have a leadership period, and have previous experience in Student Council.
- Applicants must turn in their completed application no later than April 18, 2022.
- Officers for Senior Class will meet during the summer to plan for back to school events. Further details are forthcoming.
