Articles of Clothing	Requirements
Shirt/Tops	Polo style shirt and school/college spirit shirt (limited days). A long or short sleeved solid color polo style with a collar. Acceptable colors are burgundy, gold, and black. In lieu of a collared polo shirt, college shirts can be worn on MONDAYS and school spirit shirts (club, academy, pirate, etc.) may be worn on FRIDAYS only. No midriff, see-through, or sheer shirts.
Pants/Bottoms	Solid color fitted full length pants must be worn at the waist and may not drag on the floor. Pants may not have any embellishments, embroidery, patches, rips and/or holes of any size irrespective of leggings worn underneath. No leggings, tights and/or track pants are allowed. Acceptable colors are limited to black, khaki, and blue (for denim) only. No skirts or dresses unless Business attire on designated days. No skorts.
Undershirts	Solid color t-shirts long sleeved undershirts may be worn underneath with the approved collared polo uniform short. Acceptable colors include burgundy, gold, black, and white.
Scrubs	Teal and blue scrubs (tops & bottoms) are permitted only for students enrolled in the Health Science academy.
Outerwear	Sweatshirts, sweaters, jackets, and hoodies may be worn over the approved school uniform. If this item has a hoodie, it is not allowed to be worn on the students' head during school. All outerwear is subject to school approval and must refrain from disrupting the learning environment with inappropriate or vulgar expressions.
Shoes	Sneakers or other completely closed shoes. No sandals, crocs, open toe shoes, or strapless shoes. Acceptable colors: Any
ID Badge	School issued ID badge. MDCPS School ID badges must be clearly visible at all times.

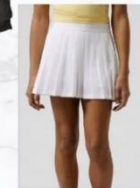

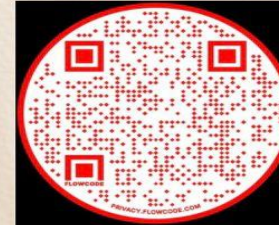

Attendance

- ▶ A student who has **ten (10) or more cumulative absences (excused/unexcused)** will not be allowed to participate in interscholastic competitions or performances for the remainder of the school year. (outdoor suspension is counted as an absence)
- ▶ You may not be **signed out early more than 10 times** in a school year to participate in activities
- ▶ A student who has **twenty (20) or more cumulative tardies (excused/unexcused)** will not be allowed to participate in interscholastic competitions or performances for the remainder of the school year.

Attendance Con't...

- ▶ ITS has configured resource mailboxes for all locations. The attendance email address for RMEC is 7371attendance@dadeschools.net
- ▶ Absences shall be reported to the student's school by the parent no later than three (3) days from the date of the absence.
- ▶ To report an absence, parents may do so electronically by emailing a statement of the cause for such absence directly to the school's attendance email address.
- ▶ The email should include:
- ▶ **SUBJECT LINE (ADMIT)**
- ▶ **BODY: the Student's Full Name, Identification Number, Date of Absence, and the Reason for the absence. (Evidence Attached as Appropriate)**
- ▶ **Email is to report absences (Admit), not for attendance corrections or anything else...**
- ▶ **Parent needs only to email once.**

Tardy Procedures

- ▶ **UNEXCUSED TARDY** 7:16 AM - 8:00 AM (Report to Cafeteria)
- ▶ After 8:00 AM Report to Attendance Office
- ▶ If student needs to excuse a tardy @ anytime they need to report to attendance office with parent/guardian.
- ▶ Students may not report tardy to class without a pass, regardless excuse or unexcused

OF TARDIES OUTCOMES

- ▶ 1 Verbal Warning
- ▶ 2 Verbal Warning/Parent Contact (Phone)
- ▶ 3 - 5 Detention (for every tardy) 6 Parent Conference / Attendance Contract
- ▶ 7-10 Indoor Suspension 1 day (for every Tardy)
- ▶ 10+ 1 day Student Success Center/Counselor Intervention

Tardy Procedures Cont'd...

Reasons for excused tardies are:

- Doctor's Appointment
- Court Appearance
- Car Accident
- Parent/Guardian must accompany student to the Attendance office.

Student ID's

- ▶ Student IDs must be worn at all times.
- ▶ Replacement IDs are \$2, replacement lanyards are \$5 can be purchased via OSP.

Safety and Security

- ▶ In each classroom, be aware of the SAFETY ZONE
- ▶ Do not leave a classroom without an official yellow pass
- ▶ Do not leave class early for lunch or at dismissal
- ▶ During PE secure all items inside your locker
- ▶ We are not responsible for cell phones, you need to secure them
- ▶ Vaping – if you are caught with a vaping device its considered a controlled substance and you will be suspended
- ▶ Zero tolerance for harassment and bullying
- ▶ Zero tolerance for fighting = suspension & possible withdrawal from RMEC

Transportation

▪ School Bus

- Transportation is a privilege NOT a right.
- It is an extension of the school.
- 'Space' Available Passes are limited.
- Three primary routes, 3###, 5###, 7###
- 3### is located on the South Campus
- 5###, 7### on the North Campus
- **Find Your Bus**

Cafeteria

- ▶ No skipping or reserving spaces for friends.
- ▶ No skipping the line for a la carte (cookies, chips, etc.)
- ▶ Eat in the designated areas.
- ▶ Clean up after yourself... no maid service!
- ▶ Line closes before the bell.
- ▶ No outside food delivery (**breaching campus security**)
i.e., Uber Eats, Pizza, soda (glass) bottles, etc.
- ▶ Parental drop off must be checked in to student services and released during lunch.

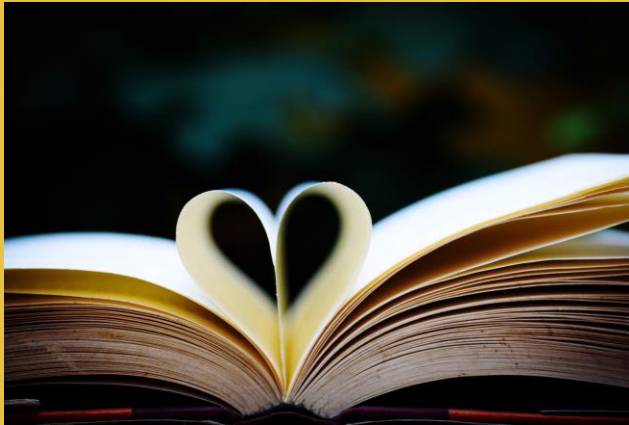

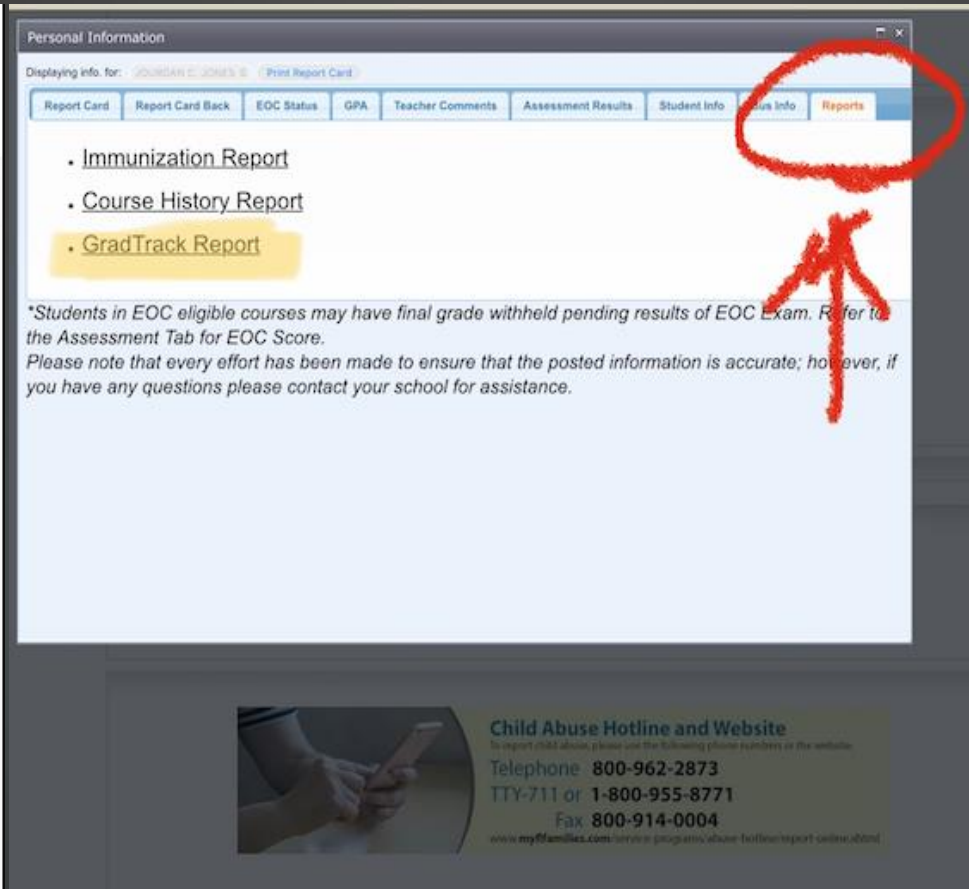
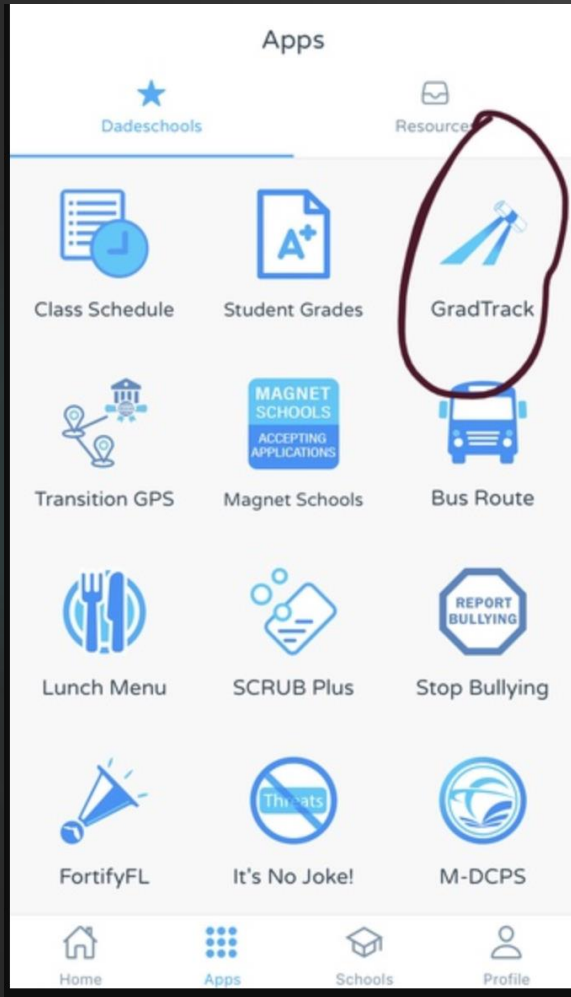

Scholar & Merit Diploma Options

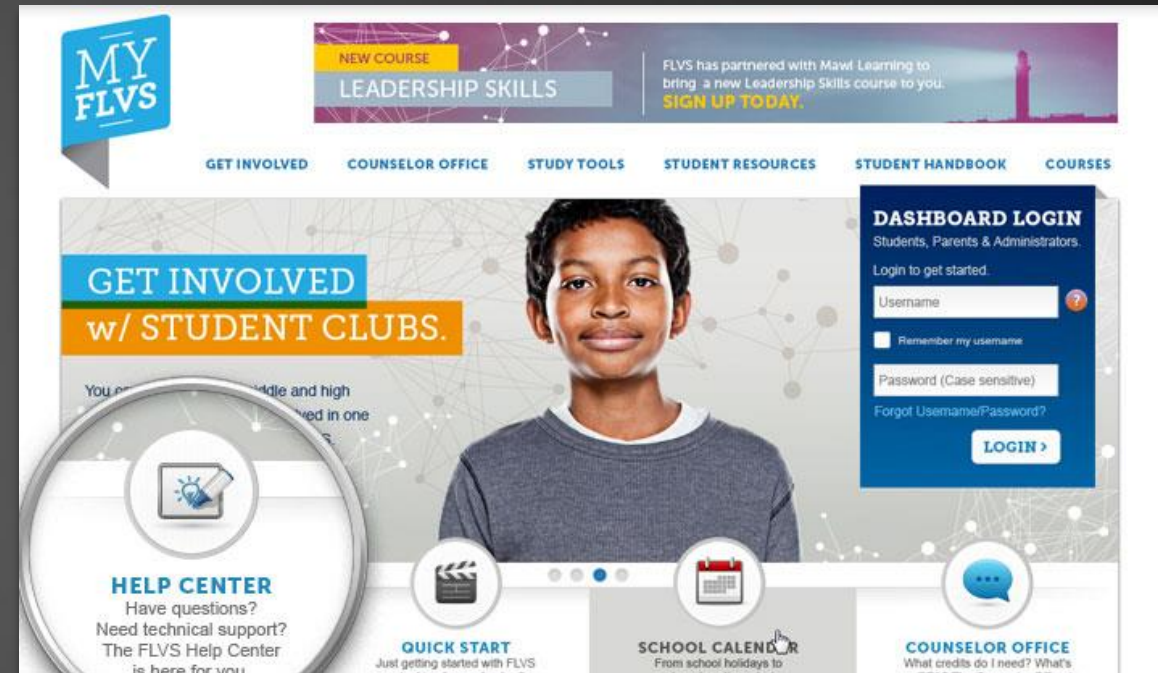
- ▶ Scholar Diploma Designation
- ▶ In addition to meeting the 24-credit standard high school diploma requirements, a student must
- ▶ Earn 1 credit in Algebra II;
- ▶ Earn 1 credit in Statistics or an equally rigorous mathematics course;
- ▶ Pass the Biology I EOC;
- ▶ Earn 1 credit in Chemistry or Physics;
- ▶ Earn 1 credit in a course equally rigorous to Chemistry or Physics;
- ▶ Pass the U.S. History EOC;
- ▶ Earn 2 credits in the same World Language;
- ▶ Earn at least 1 credit in AP, IB, AICE or a dual enrollment course.
- ▶ A student is exempt from the Biology I or U.S. History assessment if the student is enrolled in an AP, IB or AICE Biology I or U.S. History course and the student
 - ▶ Takes the respective AP, IB or AICE assessment; and
 - ▶ Earns the minimum score to earn college credit.

Merit Diploma Designation

- ▶ Meet the standard high school diploma requirements
- ▶ Attain one or more industry certifications from the list established (per s. 1003.492, F.S.)

FLVS Course Registration

- ▶ Self-register by requesting a course on your FLVS account at FLVS.net
- ▶ Counselor does not register you, only approves the course
- ▶ Graduation Requirement – one course (ex: PE, foreign language)



2H – Course Recovery

- ▶ If you have failed a core course, you need to recover the course through 2H fall term.
- ▶ Fall term begins September 12th

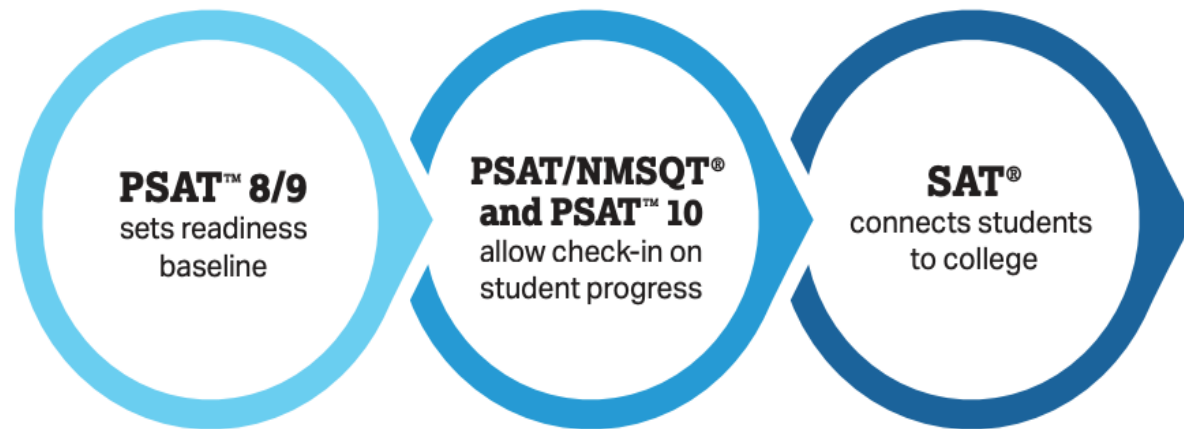

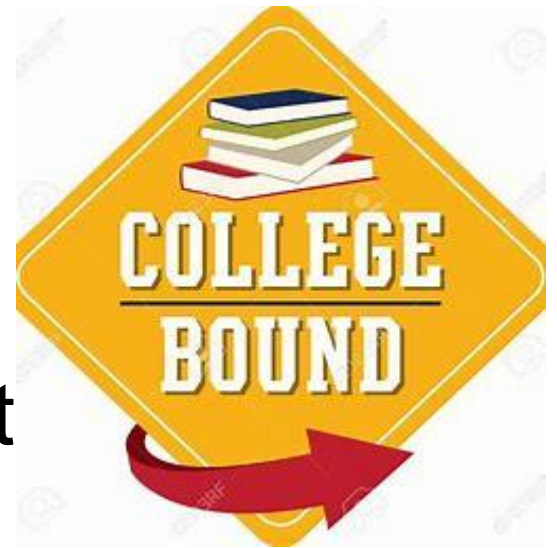

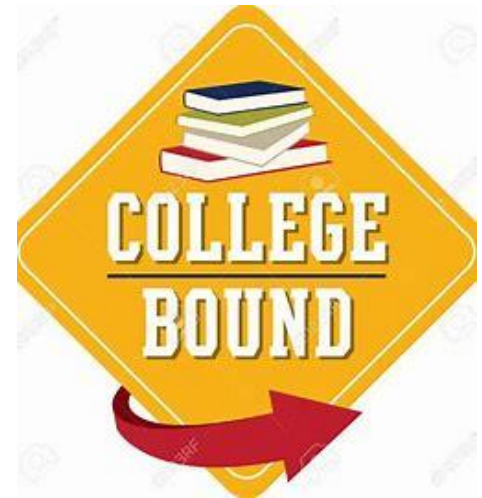

Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®)

- ▶ The PSAT/NMSQT® is an assessment given to 10th- and 11th-grade students. Eligible students in 9th and 12th grade will be notified.
- ▶ It's designed to help prepare them for the SAT, college, and careers.
- ▶ Historically, students who take the PSAT/NMSQT score higher on the SAT, on average, than those who don't take the test.
- ▶ Connections to Scholarships Students who take the PSAT/NMSQT in 11th grade may enter the National Merit® Scholarship Program, an academic competition for recognition and scholarships.
- ▶ Our other scholarship partners also use the PSAT/NMSQT to find students qualified to apply for their programs.
- ▶ These organizations give out nearly \$160 million in combined awards every year.
