

#### Cap and Gown (MANDATORY to walk graduation)

If you DID NOT pre-purchase a Cap and Gown in December. . .

- You will need a Cap and Gown Authorization Form with a QR code to make an appointment with Herff Jones to purchase a Cap and Gown.
- Counselors will need to clear you before you pick up the form.
- The Cap and Gown Authorization Form will be distributed on Monday, May 20<sup>TH</sup>.
- Be sure you closely follow the instructions on the Cap and Gown Authorization form to purchase your gown.

## Your Cap & Gown will be packaged with the following items:

- White Graduation Gown (MUST RETURN- THE DAY OF CEREMONY)
- Graduation Cap (KEEP)
- RMEC Medallion (KEEP)
- RMEC Burgundy and Gold Tassel (KEEP)
- 6 guest tickets to the graduation ceremony
- Academy Stole (KEEP)
- Your Name Reader Card (MOST IMPORTANT)

#### Name Reader Card

- You MUST bring your HERFF JONES NAME READER CARD!!
- A label has been placed on the card with your information. If you have a name that may be difficult to pronounce, please contact Mr. Figuerola.
- PLEASE check the information and make corrections if necessary.



When you pick up your
Cap and Gown packet you are required to
sign for it, acknowledging that you
received the items listed on the previous
slide.

#### WARNING:

- If you lose anything it is your responsibility to replace it.
- At this time, I am unable to reorder cap, gown and graduation regalia.
- You will need to order any lost items directly from Herff Jones.
- TICKETS Lost tickets will not be replaced.

- When you get home with your gown...
- Try your gown on.
  - Make sure the length is correct.
  - Make sure the zipper works.
- Hang your gown on a hanger to smooth out wrinkles.
- DO NOT IRON YOUR GOWN IT WILL BURN.
- You may steam your gown.
- Your gown will be collected at venue.
- No Gown = No Diploma

#### What do I wear under the gown?

- Dress Shirt and Tie (Preferably light colored, dark shirts will show through the gown)
- Dress Pants (light colored preferred, dark color acceptable)
- Dress shoes. No sneakers, No flip flops!
- Absolutely NO Jeans, shorts, or any other garment considered to be casual.

#### What do I wear under the gown?

- Dress or Skirt and Blouse light colored preferred, nothing shorter than the tips of your fingers, no strapless.
- Dress Pants and Blouse (light colored preferred, dark color acceptable)
- Dress shoes or dress sandals. No sneakers, no flip flops, etc.
- Absolutely NO Jeans, shorts, mini skirts or any other garment considered to be casual.
- Please keep in mind that you will be walking UP and DOWN a steep ramp. Highly recommended a reasonable heel.

#### HOW do I wear the Cap/Gown?

- Caps are one size fits all. (try it on)
- Keep your Tassel on the RIGHT side of the cap.
- Gowns should be wrinkle free. (DO NOT IRON)
- Gown length is mid-calf.
- Ladies wear a collar. (provided with the gown)
- Light colored clothing underneath the gown works best.
- Shirt and tie a must.



## DO NOT ALTER YOUR CAP AND/OR GOWN IN ANY WAY

No messages, pictures or any drawings on the cap or gown.

DOING SO WILL RESULT IN YOUR REMOVAL FROM THE GRADUATION CERMONY.

#### On Graduation Day, Remember . . .


- Bring your Herff Jones Card (aka) Name Card,



Graduates and Guests are asked to follow these guidelines:

- Only 6 guests per graduate.
- Guests must remain seated during the ceremony.
- Please do not move the seats.
- Everyone entering MUST have a ticket.
- Please silence all wireless devices.
- Please do not bring items into the graduation site which may distract from the dignity of the ceremony or create any action which interferes with the ceremony.
- Graduates and guests not in compliance will be removed from the premises.
- The event is being photographed / videotaped.
- NO RE-ENTRY

## EVERYONE

- Graduation will begin at <u>exactly 9:00 am</u>
- Students will walk in the procession quietly, attentively, and respectfully.
- Teacher escorts will direct the graduates to their seats.
- When the graduates enters the row, walk all the way to the end, filling every available space.
- Graduates will remain standing until you are asked to be seated.
- IMPORTANT: Graduates must look to their teacher escorts for guidance.
- Remain standing until you are asked to be seated.
- Listen attentively to all of the speakers.
- No shout outs to individual students.
- Act appropriately.

#### <u>RECEIVING DIPLOMA</u>:

- Line is led by Senior Board President, Ajaiah Glasford.
- Hand your Name Card to the announcer Mr. Figuerola.
- Walk across the stage in a dignified manner.
- Shake the principal's hand with your RIGHT hand.
- Accept the diploma cover with your LEFT hand. (Left hand over right)
- Respectfully shake the hands of the remaining administrators and dignitaries.

## RESPONSE WHEN RECEIVING DIPLOMA

- When asked what your plans are after graduation, you must respond with an answer. DO NOT say "I DON'T KNOW."
- Examples I'm going to work at (Place of employment)
- ▶ I'm going to college. I will be attending (name of college)
- ▶ If you are undecided about college/careers, you can say...I'm considering options.

## Graduation Pictures at the Ceremony You will have 2 - 3 Pictures taken.

- 1. Accepting your diploma shaking hands with the principal.
- 2. After you exit the stage.
- 3. Head shot.

## ROBERT MORGAN EDUCATIONAL CENTER <u>Conclusion of Ceremony</u>

- As you exit the stage, your picture will be taken.
- Follow the person in front of you and go back to your row.
- You may not be sitting in the same seat. . . and that's ok.
- Stand at your row and WAIT to be instructed to sit by a teacher.
- Mr. Williams will instruct everyone to stand.
- You will be pronounced GRADUATES by Mr. Williams.
- Mr. Williams will lead the class with the turning of the tassel. <u>RIGHT to LEFT</u>.
- Join in the singing of the Alma Mater.




